# Environmental Guest Presentations!

Dear Chico Teachers K-6:

Butte Environmental Council is once again sponsoring the use of Chico State's future environmental education teachers as free guest speakers in your K-6 classrooms. The speakers are from Dr. Jon Hooper's Environmental Education class (RECR/EDCI 448) where his students learn how to use wildlife and other natural resource-related activities to teach environmental concepts. Some of the previous topics that were presented to grade school children have included the salmon life cycle, the web of life, pond ecology, and local riparian animals' habitats. The presenters use interactive activities, games, and hands-on experiments to illustrate their points. Past speakers have been received with enthusiasm by the children and have received excellent evaluations by their teachers. The activities come from **Project Wild**, **Project Learning Tree**, and **Project Wet**, which are all teacher-tested curriculum materials. The presentations usually last from 45 minutes to an hour.
